School Effectiveness Review: you may have noticed that some of the teachers who are part of our leadership team have been out of class this week. This is because they have been taking part in a review of the schools which is a service we buy from the Dartmoor Teaching School and which is led by a serving Ofsted inspector. This was a good chance to see how we have progressed since our last inspections; July 16 @ Parkham and February 17 when both schools were judged as GOOD schools. This review was a rigorous event that took place over a day and a half, and looked at the quality of leadership and management, teaching, learning, behaviour and safety. The lead Reviewer was very impressed with our schools, the behaviour and politeness of the children, the quality of the teaching, the subject and senior leaders and governors who could talk very clearly about the continual drive for improvement and the journey we are on. I was very proud of the children, the progress they are making and the dedication of the staff and governors. The Reviewer could clearly see the impact of the improvements we are making to teaching and learning and agreed with the foci for further development. These can be found on the School Development plan which is on the website. Congratulations must go to all the schools community, including the parents and carers for your continuing support.
