Business transacted at the meeting:

- Need to consider salt requirements and where it will be stored.
- Emergency Plan Need to move this forward with the new council. Clerk to circulate background information to all councillors.
- 7. Decision regarding request to upgrade THHM mast technology (Novo Technologies Ltd)
 A request has been received to make a technical upgrade to the mast. The mast itself is not impacted, the works will not be disruptive and are only expected to take a day to complete.
 BBPC will receive an ongoing uplift to rental income of £2k p.a. Councillors voted unanimously to grant this request.

Vote: In favour of granting permission For: 5 (Cole, Heywood, Hooper, Mills, Watson) Against: 4 (Ainsworth, Cann, Lowe, Staveley-Brown) – Cited too many developments within Buckland Brewer already; this is not within the agreed local development plan.
